

Budget expectations from energy sector

Chennai, Jan 18: In light of the upcoming budget announcements, Wartsila - Mr. Venkatesh R., Managing Director & Director Energy Business, Wartsila, India has proposed his views regarding the expectations of the energy and power sector from the budget. "India has renewables in abundance in various parts of the country and has set a target to install

The opportunity for India is immense and could cost effectively leapfrog other developed nations into a sustainable future. As most of its infrastructure is yet to be built, it can therefore secure itself with domestically produced green energy with socio-economic benefits".

Buses, plying from Adyar intending to proceed towards Parys Corner on Kamarajar Salai will be diverted at Gandhi Statue Junction to RK Salai, Royapettah High Road, Royapettah Tower Clock, GP road, Anna Salai to reach Broadway. MTC Bus (Route No. 21G) plying from Luz Junction intending to proceed towards Gandhi

Statue will be diverted at Royapettah High Road, Royapettah Point, Royapettah Tower Clock, GP Road, Anna Salai and to reach Broadway.
